



Dear Soccer Moms and Dads,

The Sheridan County Soccer Association (SCSA) would like to welcome you to the world of club soccer. Since this may seem like a very big step for you and your child, we wanted to give you a little information about what to expect when you join one of the Sheridan Storm Soccer teams.

First of all, club teams usually travel no more than two or three weekends during the season. Six league games are scheduled for three separate weekends. Two games per day will be scheduled with other out of town teams. We usually travel to Gillette, Buffalo, Cody, Worland or Casper. Since the matches are held on single days (either Saturday or Sunday), no overnight trips are needed in most cases. Since every effort is made to schedule a weekend home game, you will more than likely only have to travel out of town on two weekends. The association will be hosting The Snickers Cup tournament at the Big Horn Equestrian Center Mother's Day weekend. Additional tournaments may be scheduled and those are optional. Each team decides if they would like to go on a case-by-case basis.

The registration fees for club soccer are \$85. Because all coaches and board members are volunteers, the fees are mainly for referees for league games, and a state association fee. The fees also cover other incidental items such as field paint, replacement nets, balls and first aid kits are also covered under the registration fees. As with any other sport, there will be some expenses that each player will have to incur. Uniforms, socks, shin guards, cleats and entry fees into optional tournaments are expenses you should expect to pay for. Even with all of the expenses above, Sheridan's fees are actually among the lowest in the state. Some clubs charge as much as \$250 per player for registration.

You will be amazed at how much your child will improve from just one season of club soccer. Registration for the spring season takes place in February; watch the local newspaper and this website for updates. If you have any other questions please feel free to ask anyone in the association.
